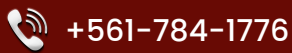

Thank you for being an essential part of our WCA community.



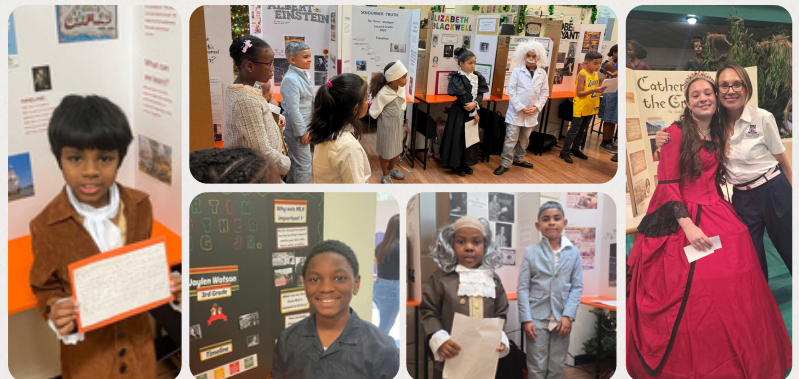
Practical Learning 26th March
